**DAY 1/ NOV 17 ARRIVAL SHANGHAI**

**(D)**

Welcome to China! Shanghai is the country's most industrious and glamorous city in China. Rated as having the highest population in the country, this growing metropolis is a fascinating blend of cultures - old and new, as well as eastern and western. It is the most influential city in Eastern China economically, culturally, and technologically, and now boasts the world's largest container trading port.

Upon arrival in Shanghai, you will be met and transferred by private coach from airport to hotel to check in. The rest of the day is at leisure until this evening to have your dinner at a local restaurant.

**Accommodation: Fairmont Peace Hotel Shanghai or similar for 1 night**

**DAY 2 / NOV18 SHANGHAI**

**(B, L)**

We spend a full day to explore Shanghai today. This morning, begin with a visit to the classical **Yu Garden**, which was commissioned by a government officer of the Ming Dynasty to create a place of tranquillity for his parents. We continue to promenade on the **Bund**, a famous waterfront that has been regarded as the symbol of Shanghai for hundreds of years. After lunch, we visit the **French Concession** which is hugely popular and sought after as the preferred residential address among expats. We stroll along its gorgeous tree-lined avenues and you can't miss the huge variety of hip cafes and restaurants, concept bars and breweries, boutiques, art galleries and antiques stores. We visit the **Shanghai Tower** and return back to the hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure. This evening you are going to a night club to relax by yourself.

**DAY 3 / NOV19 SHANGHAI - BEIJING**

**(B, L)**

We check out early and transfer to train station to take a morning **bullet train** from Shanghai to Beijing **by G6** [REDACTED]. Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be picked up and start your exciting

visit to the magnificent **Great Wall**, which is one of the 7th man-made wonders of the world. The **Mutianyu** section is one of the most well-preserved sections of the Wall and dates back to the mid-6th century. Enjoy stunning views as you stroll along this seemingly endless piece of history, which winds its way far into the distance. After lunch, we return back to hotel and the rest of day is at free until this evening, you will enjoy an authentic duck diner at a famous duck restaurant, **Da Dong Roast Duck**, repeatedly wins as "Best Chinese Restaurant of the Year" in the Beijinger's annual Reader Restaurant Awards, "Beijing Duck" and "Best for Impressing Visitors" in the 2011 Reader Restaurant Awards.

**Accommodation: Fairmont Peace Hotel Shanghai or similar for 1 night**

**DAY 4 / NOV20      BEIJING – XI'AN      (B, L)**

Today we have a half-day sightseeing tour in Beijing. In the morning, start with a visit to **Tian An Men Square**, located in the city center and it is the largest publish square in the world. We continue on a visit to the **Forbidden City**, whose acres of splendid 15th century halls and pavilions graced with imperial treasures. It was home to the Imperial Court during the Ming and Qing Dynasties. After lunch, we transfer to airport to take your flight to Xi'an, which is one of the oldest cities. As the first of China's four ancient capitals, having held that position for 13 dynasties. As the eastern-most stop for the Silk Road on a China vacation, Xian is rich with history and features ancient ruins, museums, and cultural relics.

Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel to check in and then this evening we visit **Muslim Quarter**, which is a fascinating area where you can find exotic food, interesting people (some of the residents are still look like their Arabian cousins) and great souvenir stalls. You can taste many authentic Islamic snacks, like beef or mutton Rou Jia Mo (Chinese Hamburger), northwestern style noodles, Yangrou Paomo and many other attractive snacks that will not make you disappointed. (Tentative flight: [REDACTED]).

**Accommodation: Grand Melia Xi'an or similar for 1 night**

**DAY 5 / NOV21      XI'AN – SHANGHAI      (B, L)**

This morning we visit the over six thousand life-size **Terra Cotta Warriors**, which have been standing guard by the tomb of Qin Shi Huang for 2,000 years. Discovered in 1974, the individually sculpted warriors may be the archaeological find of the 20th century. Thousands of life-size terra cotta warriors, no two alike, with their horses and chariots, are being unearthed at the mausoleum of Emperor Qin Shi Huang, who unified China in 221 BC. After lunch, we transfer to airport to take your flight to Shanghai. (Tentative flight: [REDACTED]).

Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel to check in. The rest of the day is at leisure.

**Accommodation: Shanghai Disneyland Hotel or similar (3 nights for family [REDACTED])**

**DAY 6 / NOV22 SHANGHAI**

6 Adults, 3 Children have fun at **Shanghai Disneyland Park for 2-day tickets** [REDACTED]

**DAY 7 / NOV 23 SHANGHAI**

6 Adults, 3 Children enjoy full-day at **Shanghai Disneyland Park.**

At 2:30pm, pick up 1 adult [REDACTED] and transfer to Shanghai Pudong airport take your flight, American Airlines #288 5:25pm to Chicago.

Private pick-up [REDACTED] family & [REDACTED] 4 people at Shanghai Disneyland Hotel and transfer to train station to take a bullet train to Hangzhou for **a day tour of Hangzhou with lunch (including tea farm only)**. Hangzhou is located just 100kms southwest from Shanghai, is one of China's most scenic and prosperous cities. As one of China's ancient national capitals during the Southern Song Dynasty (1127-1279), Marco Polo declared Hangzhou to be "the most beautiful and elegant city in the world". In the end of the tour, transfer to the train station and return back to Shanghai. Upon arrival in Shanghai station, transfer to Shanghai Disneyland Hotel.

**DAY 8 / NOV24 SHANGHAI**

We pick up 9 adults, 3 children from hotel and have a half-day **Water Village Tour at Zhujiajiao**, which is located in a suburb of Shanghai, an ancient water town well-known throughout the country, with a history of more than 1,700 years. Covering an area of 47 square kilometres, the little fan-shaped town glimmers like a bright pearl in the landscape of lakes and mountains.

We return to Shanghai, at 3:00pm, we transfer 9 adults, 3 children ([REDACTED] & [REDACTED]) to the airport for Airport American Airlines #128 6:10pm Flight to home. Welcome home!
