### I. Day by Day Itinerary

**Day 1: Nov 17, Sat**

**Arrive at Shanghai**

Today, fly to Shanghai with [REDACTED]. The guide will hold your name sign. Then be transferred to hotel in downtown.

**Day 2: Nov 18, Sun**

**Shanghai**

After breakfast, we drive to visit **Shanghai Tower**. The tower ranks as China's tallest building and second only to the world at large. For tourists, a Shanghai Tower visit would not be completed unless including a climb to the 'Top of Shanghai Observatory', which is the world's highest indoor observation deck. From this height, one can enjoy a unique panoramic view of the Huangpu River, the Bund on the west, and several other skyscrapers like the Jin Mao Tower and the World Financial Center on the east bank.

Next, get to **Yu Garden**.

Yu Garden, a classical garden in downtown Shanghai, boasts a history over 400 years. Each pavilion, hall, stone and stream in the garden is expressing the quintessence of South China landscape design from Ming and Qing Dynasty. Over forty spots, divided by dragon walls, wound corridors and beautiful flowers, form a unique picture featuring "one step, one beauty; every step, every beauty." The surrounding market is packed with traditional and modern shops, restaurants and temples.

This afternoon we will visit **French Concession, the Bund and shopping**. We start tour with Dr. Sun Yatsen's former residence in French Concession. This peaceful and secluded garden residence is European style building.

This evening you will visit some club or bar to enjoy the nightlife.

**Day 3: Nov 19, Mon**

**Shanghai to Beijing**

This morning, we will take bullet train [REDACTED] to Beijing. The Beijing guide will meet you at Train Station. Then we head to **Tian'anmen Square**, once the largest square in the world. Walk through and admire the many impressive buildings and monuments here, including the National Museum of China, Tian'anmen Tower, and Great Hall of the People, Chairman Mao Memorial Hall, and the Monument to the People's Heroes.

Then we head to visit the magnificent **Forbidden City**. The Forbidden City bears the legacy of housing the emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties starting in 1420. A World Heritage Site, the Forbidden City is now open for exploration by the public. After exploring this unique site, dine at a hidden Yunnan restaurant in a hutong near the Bell Tower.

After lunch we have a hutong tour with rickshaw ride, a popular program in Beijing since 1990s. Then have a cooking class in a professional school.

In the evening, we will enjoy a Kung Fu Show in a theater.

**Day 4: Nov 20, Tue**

**Beijing to Xi'an**

This morning, we drive about 1.5 hours to **Mutianyu Great Wall**, which is one of the most beautiful and much lesser crowded Great Wall in Beijing.

We are going straightly up to the top of a mountain. It is well renovated. We will take the 1,000 steps up to the Great Wall. On the wall, we could walk around about 2-3 hours depending on our time and your strength. We need hike down on the same way back. If you like we can take toboggans down the Great Wall after our tour.

After that, we transfer to airport to take flight [REDACTED] to Xi'an. Meet your Xi'an guide and transfer to Muslim Street.

**Xi'an** was once the capital city for 13 dynasties in ancient times, such as the Western Zhou (11th century to 771 BC) and Tang Dynasties (AD 618-907). Xi'an was also the starting city of the Silk Road and is believed to have been one of the four largest cities in the world from the 7th to 10th centuries.

**Day 5: Nov 21, Wed**

**Xi'an to Shanghai**

This day, drive to the **Terra Cotta Warriors** in the morning.

The Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses are the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th Century. Upon ascending the throne at the age of 13 (in 246 BC), Qin Shi Huang, later the first Emperor of all China, had work begun on his mausoleum. It took 11 years to finish. It is speculated that many buried treasures and sacrificial objects had accompanied the emperor in his afterlife. A group of peasants uncovered some pottery while digging for a well nearby the royal tomb in 1974.

After lunch, we transfer to airport to take flight [REDACTED] to Shanghai. Meet your Shanghai guide and transfer to hotel for rest.
